1) It is an order of Allah (SWT)


(Surah Al-Imran, Verse 159)

- 3) It was the practice of the sahaba (RA)

Objective of Mashwarah

- 1) To help increase the imaan in the locality of the mosque
- 2) To encourage people in the locality to spend time in the path of Allah (SWT)
- 3) To ensure that the brothers in jamaat do not waste time. Rather, work to be productive and efficient

Etiquettes of Mashwarah

- T TAQAAZAH (Needs). Aim should be to fulfil the need of the work
- R RIGHT. The ameer should start off by taking opinions from his right side
- O OBJECTION. One should not raise objections on others opinions if it is not against the laws of Shari'ah
- P-PROUD. One should not feel proud or boast over his opinion
- I INSISTENCE. One should not insist in his opinion
- C CHOICE. The choice and final decision rests with the ameer CRITICISE. One should not criticise and degrade others opinions
- A AMEER. An ameer must be appointed for all affairs in jamaat
- L LOW TONE. Opinions are to be given with love, consideration and humility

TA'LEEM

Why do we do taleem?

- 1) It is an order to seek for increase in knowledge
- 2) It is an activity that used to take place in the Masjide Nabwi at the time of the Prophet Muhammad (SAW)

Objective of taleem

- 1) To listen to promises and punishments continuously so it can leave an effect in our hearts
- 2) To bridge the gap between knowledge and action
- 3) To create interest in doing good deeds after listening to its virtues
- 4) To create a desire in the hearts of people for good deeds

Virtues of taleem

- 1) Gatherings of taleem and zikr are known as the gardens of Paradise
- 2) Special angels are appointed to search for these gatherings to come and join in

Etiquettes of taleem

- 1) Performing wudhu before sitting in these gatherings
- 2) Applying perfume
- 3) Performing two rakaats of nafl salaah
- 4) Sitting and listening attentively
- 5) Reciting the durood on hearing the name of Muhammad (SAW)
- 6) Sitting from beginning till the end
- 7) Making firm intention to act upon whatever is read

4 Important 'T' points regarding Taleem

TAZEEM: Showing full respect TASDEEQ: Having firm beleif

TA'MEEL: To put words into action

TABLEEGH: To propagate

There are 3 parts to taleem

- 1) Reading from every chapter from the 'Book of Virtues'
- 2) Forming small groups to recite the last 10 surahs with tajweed

An Example

Dear respected brothers, Alhamdu lil-lah, Allah tala has given us this oppurtunity to take a bit of our time out to act upon the sunnah of not only the Prophet(SAW), but the sunnah of all the prophets. All the the prophets called their nation towards Allah tala and gave dawaah. All the prophets used such a method that they would go to each and everyone individually and call them towards Allah tala. This is called the infiradi dawaah and thre are many examples of this in the quraan.

Nuh (AS) called his nation for 950 years towards Allah tala.

5. "He said, 'Oh my Rabb! Indeed I called my people (to tawheed) day and night."

(Surah Nooh - Verse 5)

8. "I then called to them publicly (In a gathering)
9. "... and explained (the deen) to them openly and privately."

(Surah Nooh-Verse & & 9)

Yusuf (AS) called towards the oneness of Allah tala whilst he was in the prison.

39. "O my two prison companions! Are numerous gods better or Allah, who is the One and The Almighty?"

(Surah Yusuf - Verse 29)

Musa (AS) called Fir'oun (Pharoah) towards Allah tala

23. Fir'oun said, "What is the rabb of the universe?"

24. He (Mua AS) said, "The rabb of the heavens, the earth and whatever is between the two; if you will be convinced."

(Surah Shurah - Verse 24)

Ibrahim(AS) called his father towards Allah tala.

43. "O my father! Why do you worship things (idols) that cannot hear, cannot see and cannot be of any assistance to you."

(Surah Maryam - Verse 42)

Ismail(AS) called his family towards Allah tala.

55. he used to instruct his family to perform salaah and to pay zakaah and he was beloved to his rabb.

(Surah Maryam - Verse 55)

Similarly, our Prohet(SAW) was also told to call people towards Allah tala.

1. O you wrapped in a blanket. 2. Stand up and warn (them about Allah's punishment for rejecting Imaan).

(Surah Mudatthir - Verse 1 -3)

He was told to call his relatives.

"(O Rasulullah! First) Warn your closest relatives."

(Surah Shu'ra-Verse 214)

So, the Prophet (SAW) called his relatives and then the people of Makkah towards Allah tala. When people rejected the Prophet (SAW) in Makkah he went to Taif to give dawaah. He was also rejected from there and was pelted by ill behaved people and left. The Prophet (SAW) did not give up and migrated to Madinah and gave dawaah there. The Prophet (SAW) got the sahaba (RA) ready to carry out this work. Now Allah tala has given us the ability to carry out this act which is known as the backbone of this effort. Inshallah now we will go around the locality to meet our muslim brothers, but before we go out we have to follow a few etiquettes and try to do it according to the sunnah so we can gain the most benefit from this act.

The etiquettes of JAWLAH

- 1) Groups will consist of no less than 3 people and no more than 10 people.
- 2) Each group will have an (i) ameer (ii) a guide and (iii) a speaker.
- (i)The responsibility of the ameer is to make sure the jamaat is engaged in zikr, fikr.
- (ii) The guide (preferably the local brother) will guide the jamaat to the houses. (iii) The speaker will give a talk, not too short like an announcement and not too long like a speech.
- 3) Make dua before going out to ask Allah for help and to make it easy for us.
- 4) The jamaat should walk in twos, on the right hand side, controlling their gazes, reading the third kalimaah and removing any harmful objects from the path as this is sadaqaah.
- 5) When we reach the house we knock 3 times.
- 6) If a male opens the door we should try and give da'wah for a few minutes, We do not look into the house whilst doing this. If a female opens the door we do NOT give her da'wah, instead we leave a message for what we had come for.
- 7) We return seeking forgiveness.

An example of what to say when going out and meeting a brother in Jawlah

"Assalamu-alikum W.W. My name is Umar, We are just going around to meet Muslim brothers to remind one another the purpose of our life, It comes in the Quraan

that reminding one another benefits a believer. And for this reminder Allah tala sent approx 124 000 prophets to the world. Our Prophet (SAW) also was sent down for this purpose. He reminded the ummah to worship the only One Allah and act upon what he has told us through his book and the prophet, Then only we will be successful, We think that success is in this world but Allah explaind in the Quraan

That whosoever is saved from the fire of hell and enterd into Paradise is successful. And We all know that we will die. After 100 years we wont be left here. And the only thing that will help us is the good deeds. So we try to do as many good deeds as possible, So, regarding this, after the Asr salaah there will be a small talk on imaan and yaqeen. Insha'Allah If you could make it there for Asr Inshallah it will be very beneficial for you in this world and the hearafter.

Jazakallah for your time. Assalamualikum.

SIX POINTS

Allah has blessed us with the beautiful religion of Islam. Our success in this life and the hereafter lies in practicing Islam completely. Our Prophet (SAW) was sent down as a guide to mankind. The people that followed him and met him in the state of Imaan, are known to us as "Sahabah". These Sahabah had many qualities which were present all throughout their lives. However, there were some common qualities which were present in ALL the Sahabah. If we bring these few qualities into our lives then it will be easy for us to practice coplete Islam.

What to mention for each point

For each point remember P.V.I.

P = Purpose

V = Virtue

I = Implementation

1) Firm faith in the Kalimah

PURPOSE:

We need to realize that Allah is the creator and controller of everything. The owner of all treasures, Sustainer of all the worlds and can do everything without the help of His creation.

Finally Muhammad (SAW) is the final messenger and there is no prophet to follow him. Our complete success in both worlds lies in following the Sunnah of Rasulullah (SAW), which is part of the core foundation.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a Hadith:

"He who says La ilaha illallah, it shall be a means of salvation for him though before that he may be afflicted by what is to befall him". (tabrani)

IMPLEMENT:

Always remember (D.D.M.) D; Dawah, D; Dua, M; Mushq (practice)

- 1) Recite the Kalimah correctly.
- 2) Understand the meaning of this Kalimah.
- 3) Give Dawah towards Imaan, make dua for the reality of Imaan and the mushq is to utilise our eyes, ears etc. and ponder over the greatness of Allah.

2) SALAAH

PURPOSE:

We should try to pattern our salaah with the salaah of the Sahabah (RA) so that our 24-hour life follows the quality of Salaah. Through our Salaah we should be able to gain from the treasures of Allah tala. The sahabah (RA) would solve all their problems through salaah.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a hadith.:

"The comfort of my eyes has been placed in salaah." (Nasaee)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M)

- 1) Give dawah towards salaah.
- 2) Supplicate to Allah for the reality of salaah.
- 3) Mashq (Practice): Read long optional salaah and try to create sincerity and devotion in our salaah. We try to read our salaah with all the sunnats and etiquettes.

3) Ilm and Zikr

<u>ILM</u>

PURPOSE:

Everyone should have sufficient knowledge as to distinguish between halaal and haraam, and things that are permissible and non-permissible, And to know what is right and wrong and to be aware of the order and commandments of Allah (SAW) all the time so he can live his daily life.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a hadith:

"The best amongst you is he who learns the quran and teaches it" (Tirmizi)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M.)

- 1) Give dawah towards acquiring knowledge.
- 2) Supplicate to Allah for the reality of Knowledge.
- 3) Mashq: Learn the virtues of acquiring knowledge: This can be obtained in the halqaa of taleem, also learn the everyday masa'il (laws) by going to the ulamaa.

ZIKR

PURPOSE:

To obtain this realisation and to be aware that Allah is watching us 24/7.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a Hadith:

"One who remembers Allah taala excessively is freed from hypocrisy." (Tabrani)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M.)

- 1) Dawah of zikr.
- 2) Dua for reailty of zikr.
- 3) Mashq (Practice): We do our daily tasbeehat in the morning and evening.
- (1) 3^{rd} Kalimah (2) Durud Shareef (3) Istighfaar.We also try to read 1 juz of the holy Quran and be punctual in the morning and evening dua's.

4) Ikraam-ul-muslimeen (Honouring a Muslim)

PURPOSE:

The purpose is to have full respect for all Muslim brothers because they have the Kalimaah in their heart and one should suppress his needs to fulfil the needs of others.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a Hadith:

"Anyone who consoles an afflicted person will have a reward equivlent to his." (Tirmizi)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M.)

- 1) Dawah of Ikraam.
- 2) Dua for reality of ikraam.
- 3) Mushq: One should fulfill his obligation towards his wife, Children parents and neighbours etc. and respect the elders and the ulamaa and have mercy on the young ones, One should also try his best to improve his characters in every way.

5) Ikhlaas-un-niyyah (Sincerity)

PURPOSE:

Whatever we do, We do it only for the pleasure of Allah tala. We should not do any action for anyone or for name and fame.

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a hadith:

"Undoubtedly upon resurrection people will be treated according to the intientions." (Ibne majah)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M.)

- 1) Dawah of Sincerity.
- 2) Supplicate to Allah for the reality of sincerity.
- 3) Practice checking our intentions in the beginning, middle, and end of every action. Also practice all action according to the way shown by the Prophet (SAW).

6) Tableegh (strive for deen)

PURPOSE:

One should use the health, wealth and the time Allah has given in the path of Allah, primarily for self-rectification and propagate deen as a follower of our beloved prophet (SAW).

VIRTUES:

It is narrated in a Hadith:

"He who suffers a headache in the path of Allah and hopes for a reward then all his past sins are forgiven. (Tabrani)

IMPLEMENT: (D.D.M.)

- 1) Give dawah on going out in the path of Allah.
- 2) Dua for the reality of tableegh.
- 3) Mashq: Spend 4 months at the first opportunity, 40 days per year, and the 5 local efforts ie. 3 days a month 2 Jawlah per week (one in our own locality and one in the neighbourhood locality), 2 taleem daily (one in the mosque and one at home), the daily mushwerah and minimum of two and a half hours daily.

PRINCIPLES OF DAWAH

SAMPLE BAYAAN

الحمد الله و الصلوة و السلام على عباده الذين اصطفى أمّا بعد

My dear respected brothers and elders,

Alhamdulillah, it is a great blessing of Allah (SWT) that, upon making us Muslims, and making us from amongst the best of all nations, He has also given us the ability to sit in such a blessed gathering where by just sitting our sins are forgiven.

My brothers! Everything that we see in this world, has a purpose. For instance, take a look at a car, it has been created to take a person from one place to another. This car can only be useful if it fulfills the purpose it was created for.

So, my brothers, what purpose have human beings been created for? Allah says in the Quran,

"we have not created man and jinn but for worship"

(Surah Dhaariyaat - Verse 56)

So this is the purpose of human beings. Of what use is a human if he does not worship Allah (swt). If we fulfill the purpose of life then Allah (swt) will be pleased with us in this world and the hereafter and enter us into paradise through his sheer mercy inshallah.

And to explain this very purpose of life Allah (swt) has sent approximatly 124,000 prophets to this world for the guidance of mankind. All the prophets came with the very same message.

"Undoubtedly We sent Nooh A.S. to his nation and he told them."

"O my people, Worship only Allah."

(Surah A'raaf - Verse 59)

وَإِلَى عَادٍ أَخَاهُمْ هُودًا

"To the nation of Aad We sent their brother hood."

"He told them. "O my people, Worship only Allah." (Surah A'raaf-Verse 65 & 66)

وَإِلَى ثُمُودَ أَخَاهُمْ صَالِحًا

"To the nation of Thamud We sent their brother Salih(A.S.)"

"He told them. "O my people, Worship only Allah."

وَإِلَى مَدْيَنَ أَخَاهُمْ شُعَيْبًا

"To Madyan We sent their brother Shu'uayb (A.S)"

"He told them. "O my people, Worship only Allah."

And the Prophet Muhammed (s.a.w) was sent for the same purpose. The Prophet (s.a.w) gave dawat and propagated the kalimah.

And said " لا الله and you will be succesful".

And called them towards Islam to such an extent that the people accepted Islam, and became known as the sahabah, regarding whom Allah (swt) says in the Quran,

"Allah is pleased with them and they are pleased with Allah"

(Surah Bayyinah-Verse 8)

This is because they had realised who Allah (swt) is, and that is exactly what we need to do, we need to realise who Allah (swt) is. We have forgotten our creator which is why acting upon the commandments of Allah has become extremely hard. Who is Allah (swt)? Allah (swt) is that being, that does each and every thing as he desires,

إِنَّ اللَّهَ يَفْعَلُ مَا يَشَاءُ

"Indeed, Allah does as he pleases"

(Surah Hajj-Verse 18)

He is that hat being that gives life and death,

"it is Allah who gives life and death. When he desires a matter, all he has to say is "be" and it becomes"

(Surah Al-Mu'min - Verse 68)

He is that being, besides whom none other deserves to be worshipped. Because everything that we see is the creation of Allah (swt). The sun, the moon, the stars. Allah (swt) says in the Quran,

"indeed your Rabb is Allah, who has created the heavens and the earth in six days and then turned his attention towards the throne. He covers the day with the night, each one hurring to follow the other, the sun, moon and stars are all under his command. All the creation and command belong to him, blessed is Allah, the Rabb of the universe"

(Surah A'raaf - Vers e 54)

My brothers! Allah (swt) creates things from nothing to something like this universe and like the way he created us. Allah (swt) says,

"we have certainly created man from a product of clay. Thereafter we placed him in a safe lodging (the womb) as a drop of fluid"

(Surah Mu'minoon - Verse 12-13)

ثُمَّ خَلَقْنَا النُّطْفَةَ عَلَقَةً فَخَلَقْنَا الْعَلَقَةَ مُضْغَةً فَخَلَقْنَا الْمُضْغَةَ عِظَامًا فَكَسَوْنَا الْعِظَامَ لَحْمًا ثُمَّ أَنْشَأْنَاهُ خَلْقًا آخَرَ فَتَبَارَكَ اللَّهُ أَحْسَنُ الْخَالِقِينَ

"thereafter, we made the drop of fluid into a clot of blood, then the clot of blood into a lump of flesh, then the lump of flesh into bones, after which we dressed the bones in flesh, we made him into another type of creation, so blessed is Allah, the best of all creators"

(Surah Mu'minoon - Verse 14)

My brothers, no other being can create anything from nothing. So we need to ponder over these ayaat and recognize Allah (swt) so it becomes easy to act upon deen.

And after coming to this world Allah (swt) says,

So my brothers, before this time comes we have to please Allah (saw) and spend time according to the commands of Allah (saw) the way shown to us by the prophet s.a.w. and to please and recognize Allah is no easy task, sacrifice will have to be made. This deen will only come to us through sacrifice. The way the sahabah made sacrifices. They migrated from Makkah to Madinah for the sake of this deen. Because of their sacrifices Allah (swt) has said regarding them,

That is why the prophet s.a.w and his companions are perfect role models for each and everyone of us.

So my brothers, this deen has reached us through hardship and sacrifice and through migrating from one place to another, and now it is our responsibilty to spread this deen. That is why we have been called the best of all nations. The sahabah done this, so the help of Allah (swt) came to them, because Allah (swt) has promised us his help.

The help of Allah (swt) came to the sahabah at the time of Badr, when they were just over 300 against over a thousand polytheists of Makkah. Still, Allah (swt) gave them victory. The rivers and the seas were under their command. They got help from Allah (swt) at all times. So if we want the help

of Allah (swt) we have to make some sacrifices. Our health, wealth and belongings are all from Allah (swt), so we have to sacrifice all these things in the path of Allah (swt). We should take the chance we have been given and go out in the path of Allah (swt) and please Allah (swt). So my brothers, for Allah (swt) everyone give intentions for 40 days, 10 days or whatever we can give, give intentions.

GREATNESS OF ALLAH (SWT)

My dear respected brothers, Allah swt has created the entire universe and everything that exists is in the hands of Allah swt, the sun the moon, the stars, the mountains the rivers, the oceans.

Everything that happens is due to the will of Allah, the sun cannot rise without the will of Allah, it cannot set without the will of Allah, the winds that blow, the rivers that flow, the flowers that blossom, all happen by the command of Allah.

The sun has appointed places, it rises from a different point and sets in a different point everyday, but when the 13^{th} of March will return again, the sun shall rise from exactly the same point as it did the previous year, in one ayah allah swt states,

"Who is the one that has created the heavens and the earth, who is the one that causes the rain to descend from the sky, and from this very rain Allah swt causes orchards gardens to grow,"

(Surah Naml Verse 60)

that when a person looks at these gardens, it pleases his eye, it is delightful to see. then Allah swt says... you alone are not capable of doing all this, you are not capable of creating the heavens and the earth, you are not capable of making the rain descend from the skies, and you are not capable of making these gardens grow, the amazing flowers that we see, the beautiful colours, the inspiring fragrances, Allah swt saysyou can not do this even if you tried, you could not even create a single leaf, then Allah swt ask us rhetorically;

أأله مَعَ اللَّهِ

"is there any lord besides Allah!"

QURAANIC VERSES

Here are some verses from the Quraan which could be usefull in speeches regarding the greatness of Allah.

1) Insaan (Man)

" and within your own selves are signs as well, do you not see? (Ponder over these)."

(Surah Dhaariyaat - Verse 21)

"undoubtedly, a moment of time has passed by man when he was not even something worth mentioning (he was still a drop of Semen)."

"indeed we have created man from a mixed seed (from between made spam and female egg) to test him (by prescribing duties) and we made him (a) hearing and seeing."

(Surah Insaan - Verse1-2)

"He has created you (mankind) from a single soul (Adam), after which he made a spouse (Hawa) from the soil, and also made eight pairs (male and female) for you from the livestock animals (camels, cows, sheep and goats). Allah created you an the wombs of your mothers, as a creation after a

creation in three (layers of) darkness (the abdomen, the womb, and the membrane in which the foetus develops.) That is Allah, your lord, to whom all kingdoms belongs. There is none worthy of worship but him, so where are you

turning to?

(Surah Zumar-Verse 6)

َيَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ إِنَّا خَلَقْنَاكُمْ مِنْ ذَكَرٍ وَأَنْشَى وَجَعَلْنَاكُمْ شُعُوبًا وَقَبَائِلَ لِتَعَارَفُوا إِنَّ أَكْرَمَكُمْ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ أَثْقَاكُمْ إِنَّ اللَّهَ عَلِيمٌ خَبيرٌ

"O people!, we have certainly created you from a single male (Adam) and female, and made you into various families (nation) and tribes so that you may recognise each other (so that each person may know where he belongs and who others are, your difference in linage and race does not give away superiority over others) verily the most honoured of you in Allah's sight is the one with the most piety (purity, righteousness) Allah is certainly all knowing (only he knows whos taqwa is the best)"

(Surah Hujuraat - Verse 13)

2) Animals

"There is certainly a lesson for you in livestock. (signs that point towards Allah's greatness). From what is in their bellies between excrement (filth) and blood, We give you pure milk to drink that is easily consumed. (Although the stomach of animals is an impure environment having blood and excreta always present, Allah has the immense power to create pure milk there.)."

(Surah Nahl-Verse 66)

"Allah created livestock for you so you may ride some of them (such as horses and mules), and you may eat others (such as cows and goats)."

"There are many (others) uses for you in them (such as using their skins) and (Allah has created them) so you may attain the need in your hearts by riding them. You are transported on them (on land) and on ships.(at sea, thus making your travels easy)."

"and Allah shows you his signs (Which demonstrates His power), so which of Allah's signs will you reject (when they are so clear)?"

(Surah Mu'min - Verse 79-60-81)

3) Food and water

وَهُوَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلَ مِنَ السَّمَاءِ مَاءً فَأَخْرَجْنَا بِهِ نَبَاتَ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ فَأَخْرَجْنَا مِنْهُ خَضِرًا نُخْرِجُ مِنْهُ حَبَّا مُتَرَاكِبًا وَمِنَ النَّخْلِ مِنْ طَلْعِهَا قِنْوَانٌ دَانِيَةٌ وَجَنَّاتٍ مِنْ أَعْنَابٍ وَالزَّيْتُونَ وَالرُّمَّانَ مُشْتَبِهًا وَغَيْرَ مُتَشَابِهِ انْظُرُوا إِلَى ثَمَرِهِ إِذَا أَثْمَرَ وَيَنْعِهِ إِنَّ فِي ذَلِكُمْ لَآيَاتٍ لِقَوْم يُؤْمِنُونَ

"It is He (Allah) who sends rain (water) from the sky, then by it (by the rain) he extracts (from the ground) the sprout of everything (every plant), thereafter extracting greens (green stalks) from this (sprout). Then from these (green stalks) we bring forth grain that are stacked on top of one another (with every one of these grains having the ability to grow into a complete plant bearing many more grains). From the spadix (a small stalk with little flowers enclosed in a leafy covering called a spathe) of the date palm, We extract branches hung low (heavy because they are laden with dates) and (we also germinated) orchards of grapes, olives and pomegranates, some of which are alike (in growth and looks) while others are not alike. Look at its fruits as it grows and ripens (as it develops from something worthless to something valuable). Indeed there are ayaats in this for the people who have imaan.

(Surah An'aam - Verse99)

4) Sky, Earth Sun, Moon, Day and Night

إِنَّ فِي خَلْقِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ وَاخْتِلَافِ اللَّيْلِ وَالنَّهَارِ وَالْفُلْكِ الَّتِي تَجْرِي فِي الْبَحْرِ بِمَا يَنْفَعُ النَّاسَ وَمَا أَنْزَلَ اللَّهُ مِنْ السَّمَاءِ مِنْ مَاءٍ فَأَحْيَا بِهِ الْأَرْضَ بَعْدَ مَوْتِهَا وَبَثَّ فِيهَا مِنْ كُلِّ دَابَّةٍ وَتَصْرِيفِ الرِّيَاحِ وَالسَّحَابِ الْمُسَخَّرِ بَيْنَ مِنَ السَّمَاءِ وَالْأَرْضَ لَآيَاتٍ لِقَوْم يَعْقِلُونَ السَّمَاء وَالْأَرْضِ لَآيَاتٍ لِقَوْم يَعْقِلُونَ

"Verily in the creation of the heavens and earth; in the changing on the night and day; in the huge ships which travel on the oceans carrying goods of benefit to man; (withoutsinking despite their tremwndous weight) in that water that Allah showers from the heavens, bringing life (all types of growth) to the earth after its death and casuing all types of creatures to spread out on earth; and in the varying (directions and temprature) of the winds; and the obedient clouds hanging between the earth and sky are signs for those who use their intelligence."

(Surah A-Baqara - Verse 164)

إِنَّ اللَّهَ فَالِقُ الْحَبِّ وَالنَّوَى يُخْرِجُ الْحَيَّ مِنَ الْمَيِّتِ وَمُخْرِجُ الْمَيِّتِ مِنَ الْحَيِّ ذَلِكُمُ اللَّهُ فَأَنَّى تُؤْفَكُونَ

"Undoubtedly Allah is the One Who splits the seed and the date stone. He extracts the living from the dead (such as chicken from an egg or a Mu'min from a Kaafir) and the dead from the living (such as egg from a hen or a Kaafir from a Mu'min). This is Allah! So where are you wandering astray?"

فَالِقُ الْإصْبَاحِ وَجَعَلَ اللَّيْلَ سَكَنًا وَالشَّمْسَ وَالْقَمَرَ حُسْبَانًا ذَلِكَ تَقْدِيرُ الْعَزيز الْعَلِيم

"He causes the dawn to break, made the night a rest and fixed orbits for the sun and the moon This is the arrangement of The Mighty, The All Knowing."

"It is He Who made the stars so that you may be guided by them in the darkness of the land and the occean. Indeed We have explained the Ayat for the knowledgeable ones (so that they may recognie Allah)."

"It is He Who created you from a single soul (Aadam AS), after which (He places you in) a place where you will stay (jannah or jahannam) and a place where you are kept in trust (the world/the grave). Indeed we have clearly clarified the Ayat for people who have intelligance."

(Surah An'aam - Verse95-96-97-98)

"Undoubtedly your Lord is Allah who has created the heavens and the earth in six days and then turned his attention to the throne. He covers the day with the night, (each one) hurrying to follow the other. The sun, moon and the stars are subjugated (made to be obedient) by His command. Behold! (all) Creation and command belong to him. Blessed is Allah the lord of the (entire) uiverse."

(Surah A'raaf - Verse54)
